2010-2011 School Year

Immunizations: It is a state law that students attending public school must have had all their immunizations in regulation with the Texas Department of Health. This year there have been changes to these requirements. Students without up to date immunizations may NOT be allowed to stay in school.

NEW REQUIREMENTS for 7th Graders: This year all students entering into the 7th grade will be required to have:

- Tdap booster
- Meningococcal
- Varicella Booster

NEW REQUIREMENTS for PK & KG: In addition to the standard requirements for school (listed below) students must *also* have:

- four Pneumococcal
- two Hepatitis A shots
- two Varicella shots.

STANDARD REQUIREMENTS for all students include:

- four or five DTaP*
- four OPV/IPV*
- two MMR*
- three Hepatitis B,
- one Varicella shot*, (1st grade and up) *if* they have not had the chicken pox.

* (there must be one DPT, OPV and MMR after the fourth birthday and two Varicellas are *recommended*)

Every ten years, students are required to have a tetanus booster, or "Tdap". This will affect students in 8th-12th grade.

There are several doctors in the area that will administer shots. We also have a County Health Department that operates an immunization clinic in Winnie every Friday from 8-noon, and 1-4. They can be reached at 296-8394 or 267-8356.
